To the EQC,

I am writing as a lifelong Wyoming resident to urge you to adopt the changes proposed by Powder River Basin Resource Council for expanding regulation of discharge water to include downstream impacts. As you are aware, we are getting destruction of native vegetation, irreversible damage to our soils from salts in the discharge water, and water that livestock cannot drink. We need effluent limits that protect livestock and wildlife consumption (ex. Barium TDS/EC, sulfates). I believe it is the EQC's job to protect Wyoming and am asking you to halt further destruction of our beautiful state by adding PRBRC's proposed Appendix I to Chapter 2 of the Water Quality Rules
