- > Re. proposed rules addressing environmental impacts caused by CBM discharge water by Powder River Resource Council.
 - > It is necessary and morally expedient that your Council ~~that you~~ represent Wyoming by implementing rules to deal with CBM discharge water problems. Your recommendation to take action to adopt this rule, which addresses these problems coming from CBM discharge water, is in the best interest of the land, the air, and the water quality of this state. These are definitely good stewardship concerns that outweigh any monetary motive!
 - > The destruction of native vegetation and unfit drinking water, as well as the destruction of hundreds of Cottonwood trees, & loading drainages with salts that cause permanent damage to soils, does not protect wildlife or livestock, due to the consumption of barium, TDS/EC, along with sulfates. These concerns happen due to the lack of critical thinking, and ^{an} uncaring approach to God's good earth.
 - > Therefore, we need you to implement this rule proposed by PRRC which will
