STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE REASONS  
FOR ADOPTION

The Environmental Quality Council, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Wyoming Statutes 35-11-112(a)(i), has adopted Chapter II of the Solid Waste Management Rules and Regulations.

Chapter II is entitled "Sanitary Landfill Regulations". This chapter establishes standards and requirements for the location, design, construction, operation, monitoring, closure and post-closure care of sanitary landfills.

Chapter II provides minimum standards for sanitary landfills to help ensure that facilities are operated and maintained in a manner that will result in minimal impacts to the public health and environment of the State of Wyoming.

The Council finds that this regulation is reasonable and necessary to accomplish the policy and purpose of the Act, as

stated in W.S. 35-11-102, and that it has been promulgated in accord with the rulemaking provisions of the Wyoming Administrative Procedures Act.
