STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE REASONS
FOR ADOPTION

The Environmental Quality Council, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Wyoming Statutes 35-11-112(a)(i), has adopted Chapter VIII of the Solid Waste Management Rules and Regulations.


Chapter VIII is entitled "Special Waste Disposal Standards". The rules and regulations in Chapter VIII contain disposal procedures for asbestos containing wastes.

The recent increase in asbestos removal activities has brought the need for special asbestos disposal procedures to the forefront. In order to safeguard the health and safety of landfill personnel and the general public, asbestos disposal regulations are included in this chapter.

The Council finds that this regulation is reasonable and necessary to accomplish the policy and purpose of the Act, as

stated in W.S. 35-11-102, and that it has been promulgated in accord with the rulemaking provisions of the Wyoming Administrative Procedures Act.
