## **DECLARATION OF ERIK MOLVAR**

- I, Erik M. Molvar, declare under penalty of perjury as follows:
- 1. I am presently a full-time employee of Biodiversity Conservation Alliance (BCA) and have been since September 2000, and have served as Executive Director since 2004. As a full-time staff member of Biodiversity Conservation Alliance, I am authorized to represent BCA in administrative matters.
- 2. BCA is a nonprofit conservation organization founded in 1988 and organized under the laws of the State of Wyoming. BCA is dedicated to protecting wildlands and native wildlife in Wyoming and surrounding states. Our office is in Laramie, Wyoming. BCA members live in Wyoming and many other states.
- 3. On August 12, 2009, I submitted the Amended Petition to the Environmental Quality Council for Designation of an Area Known as Sand Creek as Very Rare or Uncommon ("Amended Petition") to the Environmental Quality Council on behalf of BCA.
- 4. Also listed as presenting the Amended Petition on behalf of BCA was Wayne Prindle, who was at that time a full-time employee of Biodiversity Conservation Alliance, also authorized to represent BCA in administrative matters.
- 5. Also listed as presenting the Amended Petition on behalf of BCA was Jeff Kessler, who was at that time and is presently a member of the BCA Board of Directors, Biodiversity Conservation Alliance, serving in the capacity of Conservation Advocate, authorized to represent BCA in matters related to the Sand Creek Very Rare or Uncommon petition.
- 6. On May 11, 2010, we were notified via fax by Daniel Frank, Esq. (representing John Green) of his contention that under the Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure, the submission of a Very Rare or Uncommon Petition must be accompanied by a signature of the Party, and that such submission must be stricken "unless omission of the signature is corrected promptly after being called to the attention of the attorney or party." I therefore affix my signature hereto to correct any omission that may have inadvertently taken place under the Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure.
