Dear Kim,

In response to the assorted accusations leveled by John Green in his comment letter, I offer a brief response. I am not a lawyer, have never represented to anyone that I am a lawyer or am practicing law, and am not practicing law by filing the petition to protect Sand Creek as Very Rare or Uncommon, as determined by both the EQC and the Wyoming Bar Association. I am the Executive Director and Wildlife Biologist working as full-time staff for Biodiversity Conservation Alliance, in which capacity John Green concedes I am able to represent BCA in matters such as these.

I did not draft the original petition to designate Sand Creek as Very rare or Uncommon that was submitted by Marcia Dunsmore and the Friends of Sand Creek. I have, however, adopted this petition in substantial part and built upon it, adding additional information at the request of EQC and broadening the boundaries slightly to encompass the Dugout Gulch Botanical Area.
