TO BE DETERMINED BY ENTRIES OF APPEARANCE**


COMES NOW Petitioner Biodiversity Conservation Alliance and moves this Council to determine parties of record in the above-captioned matter by entries of appearance. In support of this Motion, Petitioner states as follows:

1. Confusion has arisen following the October 15, 2010, pre-hearing telephone conference over who is a party of record in the matter at hand. Certain participants in that telephone conference expressed that they had not yet decided whether to become a party of record. This Council's Order of October 20, 2010, appears to treat all participants in that conference as parties of record.
2. Further confusion will arise if parties of record are not determined by entries of appearance. The ability of the Council to conduct hearings in the matter at hand in a time-efficient and organized manner will be diminished if parties of record are not determined by entries of appearance.

3. Much waste of time and resources will occur if parties of record are not clearly determined by entries of appearance. Limiting copies of documents and service thereof to parties of record who have entered their appearance will clarify upon whom service is required and will conserve limited time and resources of the Council, Petitioner, and other parties of record who have entered their appearance in the matter at hand.

WHEREFORE Petitioner Biodiversity Conservation Alliance prays the Council grants this Motion to determine parties of record in the above-captioned matter by entries of appearance.




