MOTION FOR A CONTINUANCE

COMES NOW, Bridgette Reece, who is a surface and mineral owner of property located in the Sand Creek area and motions for a continuance upon the following grounds and reasons.

1. I have not received any notice from the Council of the Council's meeting which they have scheduled to be held on July 8, 2010 in Sundance, WY to deliberate the acceptance or rejection of the Amended Petition to the Environmental Quality Council for Designation of an Area Known as Sand Creek as Very Rare or Uncommon.

2. Yesterday I learned from Randall Christensen, another surface and mineral owner, that he had also not received any notice of the scheduled meeting. According to the web site docket sheet, none of the contiguous owners have been given any notice.

3. The pending petition is virtually the same as previous Sand Creek petitions. See 07-1102 and 09-1102. Previously the contiguous owners who would be affected by such a designation were all given notice but now all, including myself, have not been given any notice of the scheduled meeting. Attached as Exhibit A is a list of the entities


given notice in 09-1102 which have not been given any notice of this scheduled meeting.

4. Upon review of the notices given according to you web site, it is apparent that the Council has also failed to give notice to Golden Predator Mines US Inc. who holds numerous claims in the proposed area. Attached as Exhibit B is a list of their recorded claims. Certainly, they should also be given notice.

5. Continuing the meeting date until such time as all parties affected are afforded notice and a reasonable opportunity to appear and participate is warranted by due process and such rescheduling would not unduly prejudice the pending matter.

WHEREFORE, I would request that the scheduled July 8 2010 meeting be continued until proper notice is given to all parties entitled to notice and they are given a reasonable amount of time to prepare and participate.


