This change in location is making it very difficult to get concerned citizens to the meeting. The extra time and expense to travel to Cheyenne is just not workable for many individuals.

My resolve to help protect individuals from the harmful health impacts of air pollution becomes stronger with each passing day. My physician has not diagnosed me with any particular respiratory condition, but I persistently have reoccurring respiratory congestion and a sore throat. I have no allergies, and I have no proof that my symptoms are being caused by air pollution. However, my personal observations show a correlation between my respiratory distress and poor air quality.

As you deliberate the merits of this petition for rule making I ask you to please keep in mind that protecting the health of citizens was the driving force behind the filing of this petition. The petition contains remarks regarding some of my specific concerns. Yes, I'm anxious about my health, but most importantly I'm concerned about the impact ozone and other air pollutants have on the developing respiratory system of children.
