The three (3) existing sources are located at the Laranie River Station, 347 Grayrocks Road, approximately five (5) miles northeast of Wheatland, in Platte County, Wyoming. The applicant will install the controls determined to be BART and required under the Long-Term Strategy of the Wyoming Regional Haze State Implementation Plan to reduce visibility impacts on Wind Cave National Park located approximately 118 miles (190 kilometers) northeast of the Laramic River Station, Badlands National Park located approximately 168 miles (270 kilometers) northeast of the facility, Rawah Wilderness Area located approximately 103 miles (165 kilometers) southwest of the facility, and Rooky Mouniquian National Park located approximately 115 miles (185 kilometers) southwest of the facility. The three (3) existing sources are located at the Laramie River

facility.
