RE: Notice of Violation and Order Docket Number #4672-10

Dear Mr. Castillion

Enclosed is a Notice of Violation and Order Docket Number 4672-10 issued to the City of Green River Public Services Department for the discharge of pollutants into waters of the state. Specifically, the discharge was from soil erosion from a residential area (California Drive) caused by storm water runoff from a storm water outfall owned and operated by the City of Green River Public Services Department. The sediment was transported off the residential area down a steep embankment and into an unnamed tributary to the Green River. Sediment deposits carried into the Green River formed a delta estimated to be approximately 50 feet across.

ANY APPEALS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL FROM THE ATTACHED ORDER MUST BE MADE IN WRITING WITHIN THE TEN (10) DAY LIMIT PRESCRIBED BY WYOMING STATUTE 35-11-701(c). Chapter 1, Section 3 of the Department of Environmental Quality Rules of Practice and Procedures set forth the requirements for the initiation of appeal proceedings. You are urged to review all of the provisions of the Rules of Practice and Procedures as they relate to this action by linking to website provided: <http://soswy.state.wy.us/Rules/RULES/5675.pdf>.

To appeal this Order and request a hearing, you must file two (2) copies of your written petition. The first hearing petition shall be mailed to the Chairman, Wyoming Environmental Quality Council, Room 1714, Herschler Building, 1st Floor West, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. The second petition shall be mailed to the Director, Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Herschler Building, 4th Floor West, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. Both petitions must be sent by certified mail return receipt requested.




