NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND ORDER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

- 1. Town of Wamsutter (Wamsutter) operates a wastewater treatment plant and lagoon in Wamsutter, Wyoming in Sweetwater County, Wyoming which is permitted to discharge through the Wyoming Pollution Discharge Elimination System permit WY0053414.
- 2. Part I of the above referenced permit, under the Monitoring and Reporting Requirements requires that effluent monitoring results obtained during the previous three month(s) shall be summarized and reported on a Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR). The DMRs are to be submitted to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and postmarked no later than the 28th day of the month following the completed reporting period. To date the DEQ/Water Quality Division (WQD) has not received the Second Quarter 2010 DMRs.
- 3. DEQ has issued 2 previous Letters of Violation (LOV) to the Town of Wamsutter for late submittal of DMR's. This continued late submittal of DMR's to the DEQ is a violation of permit requirements.
- 4.. This Notice is being sent to you pursuant to W.S. 35-11-701(c)(i), which requires that in any case of the failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation, the director of the Department of Environmental Quality shall cause a written notice to be issued and served upon the person alleged to be responsible;

ORDER

BEFORE THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL – STATE OF WYOMING

WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Wamsutter shall immediately submit the complete and accurate delinquent report to the WQD. This information shall be received by the WQD no later than 20 days from the date of this NOV and Order.
- 2. Within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Order, Wamsutter shall submit to the WQD a written description of actions taken to insure that future Discharge Monitoring Reports will be submitted on time.

This ORDER is final unless, no later than ten (10) days after the date this notice is received; it is appealed by filing a written request for a hearing before the Environmental Quality Council. If a hearing is requested, the hearing petition shall be mailed to the Chairman, Wyoming Environmental Quality Docket No. 4723-10 Page N- 2

The second petition shall be mailed to the Director, Wyoming Department of the Environmental Quality, Herschler Building, 4th Floor West, 122 West 25th St., Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. Both petitions must be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested.

NOTHING IN THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NOV) AND ORDER shall be interpreted to in any way limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this NOV AND ORDER be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.
