Enclosed you will find a Notice of Violation under the provisions of Wyoming Statute § 35-11-701(c). The Notice of Violation is based on the inspection conducted by Bill Hogg on August 4, 2009. The violation is for failure to reclaim the mining disturbance. The LQD has determined that this enforcement action and Order requires the operator to eliminate hazards on the permit area and to reclaim the site.

Please note that the Order requires you to take corrective action to mitigate the violations that are outlined in the attached Notice of Violation and Order. The Order defines the necessary action to correct the violation and the requested time frame for this action.
