JOINT STIUPLATION TO MODIFY
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ON CONSENT

On May 23, 2011, the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Solid and Hazardous Waste Division (DEQ) and Uinta County entered into an Administrative Order on Consent for the purpose of brining the Bridger Valley municipal solid waste management facility operations into compliance with the permit requirements of Wyo. Stat. Ann. § 35-11-502 and the DEQ Solid Waste Rules and Regulations.

In order to allow for Uinta County to finalize property ownership issues with the United States Bureau of Land Management, on which permitting of the Bridger Valley facility depends, Uinta County and DEQ now agree that the original Administrative Order on Consent should be modified as follows:

1. A renewal application shall be submitted to the DEQ/SHWD no later than ~~September 30, 2011~~ January 6, 2012.

All other terms of the original Administrative Order on Consent not specifically modified above remain unchanged and in effect as originally ordered by the Environmental Quality Council.

Therefore, Uinta County and DEQ now jointly stipulate to the above modification of their original May 23, 2011 Administrative Order on Consent and

request that the Council enter an order approving, incorporating, and binding the parties to their Joint Stipulation as modified herein.
