DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY/LAND QUALITY DIVISION'S PRE-HEARING MEMORANDUM

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ)/Land Quality Division (LQD) by and through its attorney, John S. Burbridge, Senior Assistant Attorney General, hereby submits its Pre-Hearing Memorandum and states to the Environmental Quality Council (EQC) the following:

SUMMATION OF THE FACTS

On September 1, 2006 the DEQ/LQD issued Notice of Violation # 100516 (NOV) to Landrica Development Company, Kfx Mine (Landrica) for failure to follow its approved mine plan. The NOV was issued for dumping liquids into an un-permitted treatment site. Landrica requested an informal conference before the Director, held on November 6, 2006. The Director's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order was issued on December 11, 2006. The Order reduced a recommended fine of \$35,000.00 to \$25,000.00 immediately with the potential for the fine to be further reduced by \$10,000.00 to a total of \$15,000.00 upon a showing by Landrica that remedial action has occurred. Landrica appealed the Director's decision on December 22, 2006.

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LEGAL ISSUE

- 1. Did Landrica fail to comply with WYO. STAT. ANN. § 35-11-415(a) and (b)(ii)?
- 2. Was the civil penalty assessed by the DEQ consistent with LQD Rule and Regulation, Chapter 16, Section 3?
