SUMMATION OF THE FACTS

Teletractors, Inc. (Teletractors) filed its small mine application with the Division, small mine permit application TFN 4 2/261. The mine is to be located approximately 2 miles south of Pinedale, Wyoming. After proper notification that Teletractors' application was complete, interested parties timely filed objections to the permit with the Division. The objections identify truck traffic and location with regard to an irrigation ditch and public access point to the New Fork River. The Division has reviewed the application and determined that the it is complete, in full compliance with Wyoming Law and is ready to issue the permit.

Is Teletractors' permit application complete and should the DEQ issue Teletractors a permit to mine pursuant to Wyo. STAT. ANN. § 35-11-406?
