PRE-HEARING DISCLOSURES

Teletractors, Incorporated, pursuant to the Environmental Quality Council's Notice of Hearing and Order, hereby submits its Pre-Hearing Disclosures.

SUMMATION OF THE FACTS

Teletractors, Incorporated filed its small mine application with the Division, small mine permit application TFN 4 2/261. The proposed mine is to be located approximately 2 miles south of Pinedale, Wyoming. After proper notification that the application was completed, interested parties timely filed objection to the permit with the Division. The objection identifies truck traffic and location with regard to a public river access for floaters and fishermen on the New Fork River. The Division has reviewed the application and determined that it is complete, in full compliance with Wyoming Law and is ready to issue the permit.

LEGAL ISSUE

Is Teletractors, Incorporated mine permit application complete and should the DEQ issue our permit to mine pursuant to Wyo. Stat. Ann. § 35-11-406?
