We would like to voice our concerns we have with Arrowhead Concrete's application for a small mine permit. The publication states that this application is for the next 30 years. We are objecting to the proposed mining operation because they are not complying with their existing mine permit conditions of controlling the dust they are producing on the "Blue Rim Road" (County road 7). They are using this as their haul road and it is not adequate for this type of operation.

As property owners we live adjacent to Arrowhead's haul road, within approximately 1/4 mile, and in the same valley that the dust blows through. Arrowhead's lack of attention to dust control has had a major impact on the quality of our air. Several families and land owners in the "Gaensslen Subdivision", and the "Gaensslen Ranch", have complained to the county and the DEQ. To date nothing has been done to alleviate the situation, which we understand is Arrowheads responsibility.

Our homes located across from Blue Rim Road, were here before Arrowhead's operation started. These trucks run almost 24/7 and I can see no way that the county could keep up with controlling this dust. The thought of having to tolerate this for the next 30 years is not appealing.
