Subject: Bond Forfeiture, Phone Conversations

A voice message was left on my answering machine from Malcom Shepard, operator of DirtWorks (307-660-1884). He stated that he had given the voluntary bond forfeiture forms to his attorney and the bankruptcy trustee. It is his understanding that he has no say over his money and he can not sign the forms.

I called him back at 7am. He gave me the following information. The Bankruptcy trustee is Randy Royal (307-765-4433), 524 5th Ave. South, Greybull, WY. 82426. Mr. Shepard's attorney is Felix J, Sowadg (307-686-4164), 603 South Gillette Ave., Gillette, WY. 82716. He was given John Burbridge name and telephone.

He stated the above and said that there is no money left; they have even gone after his house. I explained that the \$9996.00 bond was a CD #62881 and is made out to the Department of Environmental Quality and we are holding it. The CD should not be considered part of the bankruptcy proceedings. He stated that he would get the NOV to his attorney and the bankruptcy trustee.

On March 14, 2008, I returned a call from Randy Royal. He did not know about the DirtWorks permit with Land Quality. Conversations were held concerning the CD that LQD is holding for the reclamation of the Carbon County disturbance. He was told that the bond amount was not expected to cover the cost of the reclamation. He stated that he would not fight the bond forfeiture proceedings but would require a "motion of stay" from the AG's office. I gave him John Burbridge name and telephone number. I also left a voice message on John's machine.

I returned Malcom Shepard's call as requested. He has received the NOV and was calling as required by the cover letter. He does not think that a settlement agreement meeting would help. He has no resources to reclaim, no money to go after and can not sign the forms.

We talked about my conversations with Randy Royal and him saying that he would not sign voluntary forfeiture paper but would considered a motion of stay. John indicated that he was not interested in this and we would just continue with NOV and bond forfeiture.

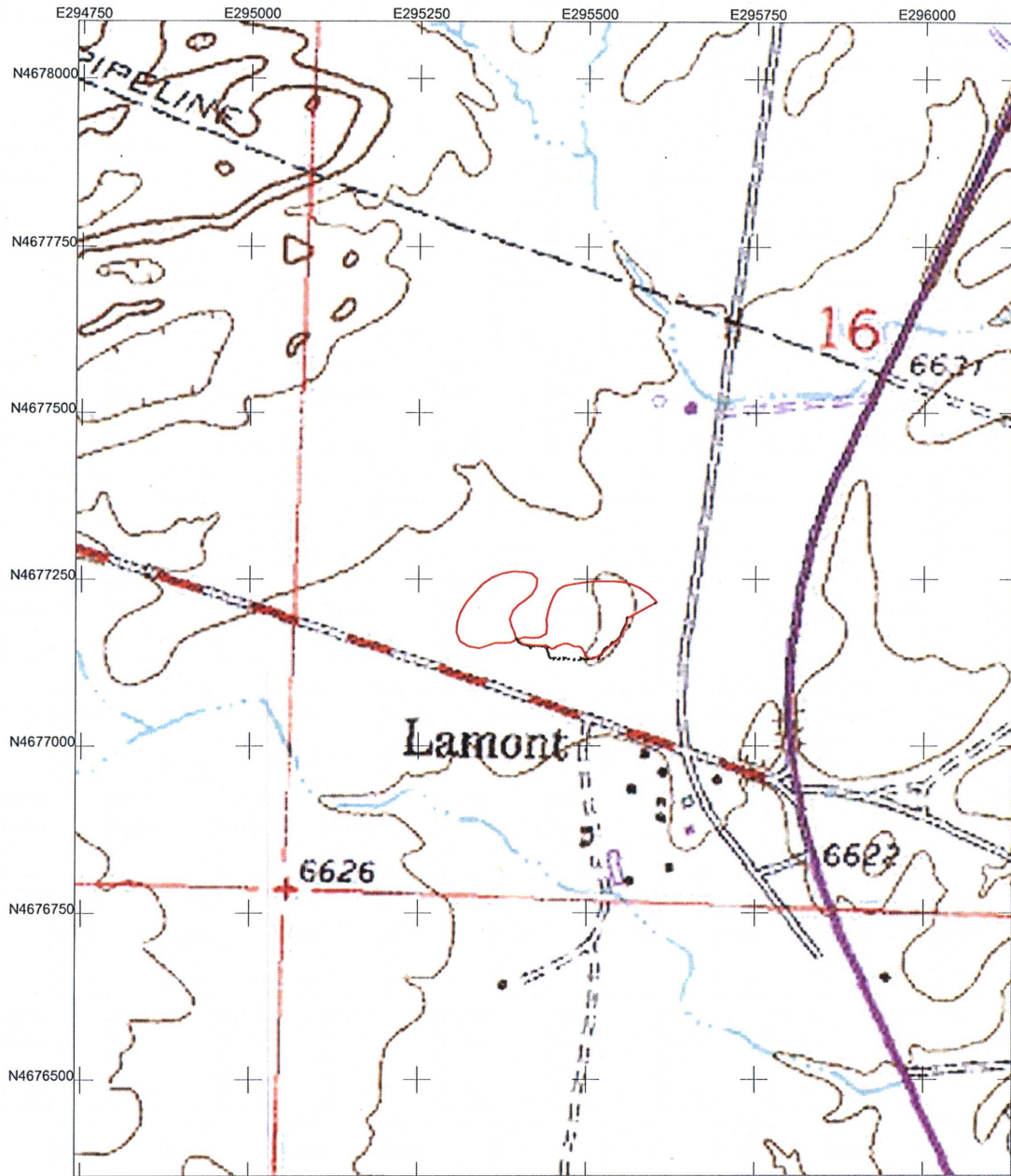

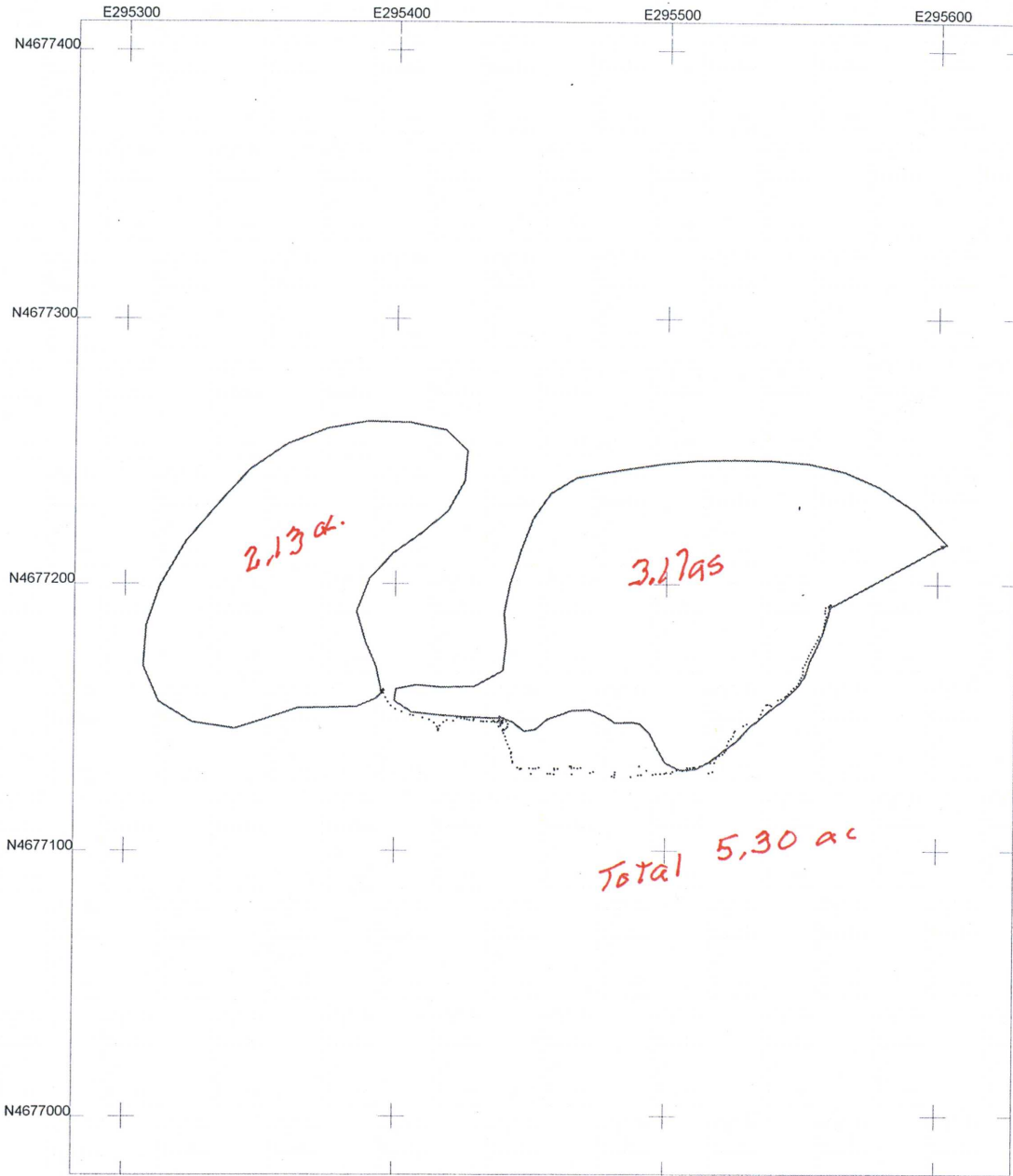
