MOTION FOR BOND FORFEITURE

The Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division (Division), through the Office of the Attorney General, hereby moves the Environmental Quality Council (Council) for an order forfeiting the bond of Snake River Sporting Club Development Co., LLC (Snake River), and as grounds for this motion, states the following:

1. Snake River holds permit 1117ET, authorizing it to operate a gravel mining operation located in the NW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 32, Township 39N, Range 116W and the NW1/4 SE1/4, of Section 5 of Township 38N, Range 116W in Teton County, Wyoming. *See Exhibit A.*
2. Snake River posted a performance bond for the purpose of assuring reclamation of the mining site in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00). The bond is a letter of credit, number 3319173-3, issued by the Jackson State Bank, now Wells Fargo Bank. *See Exhibit B.*
3. There has been no activity or reclamation at this site since October of 2007.


4. In 2009, Snake River filed for Chapter 7 bankruptcy and their authorization to conduct business in Wyoming was revoked by the Secretary of State for non-payment of taxes. *See Exhibit C.*
5. The DEQ issued Notice of Violation (NOV) No. 4748-10 to Snake River on October 18, 2010, because Snake River failed to reclaim the mining disturbance after mining operations ceased. *See Exhibit D.*
6. Based on these facts, the DEQ determined Snake River's reclamation bond should be forfeited.
7. The Council approved the DEQ's request to initiate bond forfeiture proceedings against Snake River on January 13, 2011. *See Exhibit E.*
8. The DEQ then requested that the Office of the Attorney General begin this proceeding.
9. On January 28, 2011, the Office of the Attorney General sent notice to Snake River by certified mail that the Council would enter an order forfeiting its bond unless it demanded a hearing before the Council within thirty (30) days. Wells Fargo was also sent a copy of the notice to Snake River by certified mail. *See Exhibit F.*
10. Notice sent to Snake River was returned to the Office of the Attorney General on February 3, 2011, as "vacant" and "unable to forward." Wells Fargo received notice on or about January 31, 2011. *See Exhibit G.*

11. Neither the Office of the Attorney General nor the Council has a record of a request for a hearing before the Council from Snake River or Wells Fargo.
12. WYO. STAT. ANN. § 35-11-421(b) states that if no demand is made by the operator within thirty days of his receipt of the notice, then the Council shall order the bond forfeited.
13. The DEQ and the Attorney General's Office have satisfied all of the statutory prerequisites to this bond forfeiture, and the Council should order the bond forfeited.

WHEREFORE, the DEQ respectfully requests that the Council enter an order requiring Snake River, to forfeit its reclamation performance bond to the DEQ to be used to reclaim those lands affected by Snake River's activities under permit number 1117ET.

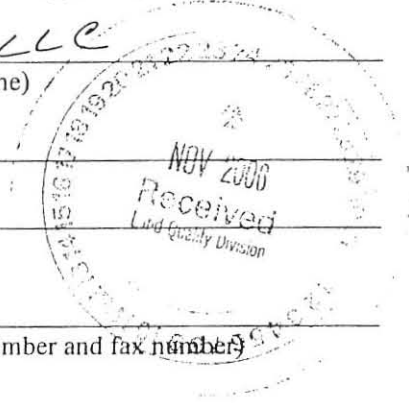

- A signed and dated statement from the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality and the Land Quality Administrator in any one of three following forms:
 - A. "The undersigned hereby advises that an order in an amount identical to the amount of the sight draft which this statement accompanies has been entered by the environmental quality council pursuant to W.S. 35-11-421, forfeiting all or part of the amount of the credit because of any violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act. by Snake River Sporting Club Development Company, LLC, Permit No. 1117ET. A Certified copy of the order of forfeiture is attached."
 - B. "The undersigned hereby advise that a Settlement Agreement in an amount identical to the amount of the sight draft which this statement accompanies has been signed on behalf of the Department of Environmental Quality and on behalf of the operator, Snake River Sporting Club Development Company, LLC, Permit No. 1117ET, in which the parties have agreed to an amount due to the Department because of a violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act, and that Snake

River Sporting Club Development Company, LLC has failed to pay the amount due within the period of time specified in the agreement.”

- C. “The undersigned certify that the operator Snake River Sporting Club Development Company, LLC, Permit No. 1117ET, has not filed with the Department an extension of this letter of credit, a substitute letter of credit or other acceptable evidence of financial responsibility in the place of the letter of credit; and that it is thirty (30) days or less until the current or any amended expiration dater of this Irrevocable Letter of Credit.”

Pursuant to Chapter XII, land Quality Division Noncoal Regulations, the bank shall give immediate notice to the permittee and the director of the Department of Environmental Quality of: (a) any notice received or action filed alleging the insolvency or bankruptcy of the bank; or (b) alleging any violations of regulatory requirements which could result in suspension or revocation of the bank’s charter or license to do business; or (c) the bank, for any reason, becomes unable to fulfill its obligation under the letter of credit.

Each draft must bear upon its face the clause “drawn under Letter of Credit No. 3319173-3, dated January 10, 2008, and the total of this draft and all other drafts previously drawn under this Letter of Credit does not exceed \$10,000.00.”

It is a condition of this Letter of Credit that it shall be deemed automatically extended without amendment for one year from the present or any future expiration date hereof, unless ninety (90) days prior to any such date we shall notify the Director of the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality in writing by certified mail at the above mentioned address that we elect not to consider this Letter of Credit renewed for any such additional period. Upon receipt by you of such notice, you may draw hereunder.

We hereby agree with you that drafts drawn under and in compliance with the terms of this Letter of Credit will be duly honored if presented to the above-mentioned drawee bank on or before June 14, 2008. All questions arising in connection with this Letter of Credit shall be determined according to the laws of the State of Wyoming.

This Letter of Credit is subject to the Uniform Customs and Practice for Documentary Credits, 1993 revision, International Chamber of Commerce publication No. 500, except to the extent it is inconsistent with the laws of Wyoming.





NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:


1. Notice of Violation is being sent to you pursuant to W.S. §35-11-701(c)(i) which requires that a written notice shall be issued in the case of failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation.
2. On July 15, 2010, the annual inspection of the Snake River Sporting Club Development Co., LLC, Limited Mining Operations Notification No. 1117ET, was conducted by John Erickson of the Land Quality Division District II office. The pit is located in the NW¼SE¼ Sec. 32, T.39N., R.116W., and the NW¼SE¼ Sec. 5, T.38N., R.116W., Teton County, Wyoming.
3. The inspection revealed that there has been no mining or reclamation activity at the pit since the previous Land Quality Division inspection conducted October 24, 2007.
4. Snake River Sporting Club has failed to file any Annual Reports since their Assumption of Limited Mining Operation No. 1117ET on November 5, 2007.
5. Snake River Sporting Club has filed for Chapter 7 bankruptcy and the Corporation's authority to conduct business was revoked by the Wyoming Secretary of State on March 14, 2009.
6. Land Quality Division Non-Coal Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, Section 5.(a)(i) states that an operation will be considered to be abandoned if the corporation conducting the operation goes out of business or if no further mining or reclamation work has been done from one annual report to the next.
7. Failure to commence reclamation after mining operations have ceased or within 30 days after the abandonment of the mining operation is a violation of Land Quality Division Non-Coal Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, Section 5.(a).
8. Failure to provide an Annual Report is a violation of Land Quality Division Non-Coal Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, Section 3.
9. The violations have not been corrected or remedied, nor has the operator provided any information to the Land Quality Division concerning the violations.
10. W.S. 35-11-901(a) provides that any person who violates any provision of the Environmental Quality Act or any rule, standard, permit, license or variance adopted thereunder is liable to a penalty of ten thousand dollars(\$10,000.00) for each day of violation, which penalty may be recovered in a civil action brought by the Attorney General in the name of the People of the State of Wyoming.

Nothing in this Notice of Violation (NOV) shall be interpreted to in any way limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this NOV be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.
