McMURRY READY MIX COMPANY PRE-HEARING DISCLOSURES

McMurry Ready Mix Company (McMurry), by and through its Attorneys, Hageman & Brighton, P.C., and pursuant to the Environmental Quality Council's (Council) July 9, 2010 Notice of Hearing and Order, hereby submits its Pre-Hearing Disclosures:

SUMMATION OF THE FACTS

McMurry filed an application to revise mining permit #739. After proper notification that McMurry's application for permit revision was complete, Mike and Cheryl Newberry (Newberrys) submitted a written objection to the Land Quality Division ("LQD" or "Division") of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). The Newberrys have

alleged that McMurry's proposed revision will adversely affect Smiley Springs by changing its water flow and by causing it to no longer flow. The Newberrys also allege that water wells drilled by McMurry have mitigated some of the damage to them but that McMurry's mining activities have adversely affected water rights in Smiley Springs dating back to the 1920s. Lastly, the Newberrys generally allege that McMurry's application does not take into account long term affects of its mining operation on Smiley Springs.

The DEQ/LQD has reviewed McMurry's application and revised mining permit and has determined that its proposed mining activities will not adversely affect Smiley Springs. The Division has also determined that McMurry's application for revision to permit #739 is complete and in full compliance with Wyoming law. The Division is ready to issue the permit.

McMurry disagrees with the Newberrys' contentions. McMurry further states that it has fully complied with the May 15, 2006 Water Well Drilling, Usage and Ownership Agreement (Agreement) entered into with the Newberrys.

LEGAL ISSUE

Whether McMurry's application for permit revision is complete and whether the Division should issue McMurry a permit revision pursuant to WYO. STAT. ANN. § 35-11-406.
