PUBLIC NOTICE

The McMurry Ready Mix Company of Casper, Wyoming has applied for a revision of its mining Permit #739, originally approved October, 2005 from the Land Quality Division of the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality. The mining permit area for the mining of sand & gravel is located in: Section 14, Township 21 North, Range 88 West, Carbon County, Wyoming. The Wyute Pit is approximately 1.2 miles West of Rawlins, Wyoming and can be found on the Rawlins Peak USGS quadrangle map. The mining operation began October 2005 and is estimated to continue until 2023. The land, after mining, will be returned to wildlife habitat, livestock grazing and recreational uses. The revision includes updates to the Other Permits section, the Mine Plan, the Reclamation Plan and a Hydrogeologic Assessment. Information regarding the proposed revision may be reviewed in the Office of the Land Quality Division, Department of Environmental Quality in Cheyenne, the field office of McMurry Ready Mix onsite at the Wyute Pit, or the Carbon County Clerk's Office in Rawlins, Wyoming. A complete revision package including an index sheet identifying all proposed changes is available for public viewing. Written objections to the proposed permit revision must be received by the Administrator of the Land Quality Division, Department of Environmental Quality, Herschler Building, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, WY 82002, before the close of business on July 7th, 2010. Only the revision is open for public review. If an objection is submitted a public hearing shall be held within twenty (20) days after the final date for filing objections unless a different date is stipulated to by the parties.

The Environmental Quality Council of Director shall publish notice of the time, date and location of the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the locality of the proposed operation once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks immediately prior to the hearing. The hearing would be conducted as a contested case in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act (W.S. §16-3-101 through §16-3-115), and the right of judicial review shall be afforded as provided in that act. The Wyoming Oil and Gas Commission will be mailed a copy of the application mine plan map as required in W.S. §35-11-406(j).
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
