
**JOINT STIPULATED MOTION TO FURTHER MODIFY DEADLINES
AND SUPPLEMENT WITNESS DESIGNATIONS**

1. On July 18, 2011, the parties to this proceeding executed and filed with the Council a Joint Stipulated Motion to Modify Prehearing Deadlines (the "Stipulated Motion"), whereby the parties stipulated and agreed to a bifurcated designation of exhibits.
2. In accordance with the Stipulated Motion, the first designations, which were exchanged by the parties and filed with the Council on July 20, 2011, included all exhibits other than those specific volumes or sections of the Lost Creek Application for Permit to Mine (the "Application") that are most relevant to the issues presented by the petitioner in the Amended Written Objections and which the petitioner may designate for use as exhibits during the hearing (such separately designated volumes or sections the "Application Exhibits"). The second designations are to include those Application Exhibits, and are due to be designated and exchanged under the terms of the Stipulated Motion by Monday, July 25, 2011.
3. In order to fully prepare for the hearing in this matter and to achieve the objectives set forth in the Stipulated Motion that relate to the separate designation of the Application Exhibits, the parties have agreed to an additional two-day extension of the stipulated deadline for designating and exchanging Application Exhibits, to 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 27, 2011.
4. The parties have further agreed to a two-day extension of the deadline set forth in the Presiding Officer's Order dated July 7, 2011 for the filing of preliminary motions. Pursuant to this stipulation, the deadline for filing any preliminary motion shall be 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 27, 2011.
5. The parties further agree that petitioner shall file a supplemental or modified witness list describing the substance of the proposed testimony to be offered by each of its designated witnesses by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 27, 2011.
6. This Motion is not intended to and shall not affect any other deadlines set forth in the Order or that may otherwise apply to these proceedings pursuant to the Council's Rules of Practice and Procedure.






