**MOTION FOR BOND FORFEITURE**

The Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division, through the Office of the Attorney General, hereby moves the Environmental Quality Council for an order forfeiting Wolverine Operations, LLC's cash reclamation performance bond and as grounds for this motion states the following:

1. Wolverine holds permit number 1240ET authorizing it to operate a limited scoria mining operation in Section 28, T55N, R78W in Sheridan County, Wyoming. *See* Exhibit A.
2. Wolverine posted a cash reclamation performance bond for the purpose of assuring reclamation of the mining site in the amount of \$4,000.00. *See* Exhibit B.
3. Wolverine has failed to demonstrate active mining status and no site-reclamation activity has been observed or reported.
4. The DEQ has not received an annual report from Wolverine since March 8, 2005.
5. Wolverine failed to respond to numerous communications from DEQ requesting information regarding the status of Wolverine's small mining operation.


6. The DEQ issued Notice of Violation (NOV) No. 5061-12 to Wolverine on December 3, 2012, due to Wolverine's failure to reclaim the mining site. *See Exhibit C.*
7. Based on these facts, the DEQ determined Wolverine's cash reclamation performance bond should be forfeited.
8. The Council approved the DEQ's request to initiate bond forfeiture proceedings against Wolverine on March 14, 2013. *See Exhibit D.*
9. On May 6, 2013, the DEQ requested that the Office of the Attorney General begin bond forfeiture proceedings. *See Exhibit E.*
10. On May 29, 2013, the Office of the Attorney General sent notice to Wolverine by certified mail that the Council would enter an order forfeiting Wolverine's cash reclamation performance bond unless Wolverine demanded a hearing before the Council within thirty (30) days. *See Exhibit F.*
11. Wolverine received the notice on or about June 6, 2013 and Wolverine's registered agent receive the notice on or about May 30, 2013. *See Exhibit G.*
12. Neither the Office of the Attorney General nor the Council has a record of a request for a hearing before the Council from Wolverine.
13. WYO. STAT. ANN. § 35-11-421(b) states that if no demand is made by the operator within thirty (30) days of receipt of the notice, then the Council shall order the bond forfeited.

14. Based on the foregoing facts, the DEQ and the Attorney General's Office have satisfied all statutory prerequisites to the forfeiture of Wolverine's cash reclamation performance bond, and the Council should order Wolverine's bond forfeited.

WHEREFORE, the DEQ respectfully requests that the Council enter an order forfeiting Wolverine's \$4,000.00 cash reclamation performance bond to the DEQ to be used to reclaim those lands affected by Wolverine's activities under permit number 1240ET.


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

1. Notice of Violation (NOV) is being sent to you pursuant to Wyoming Statute §35-11-701(c)(i) which requires that a written notice shall be issued in the case of failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation.
2. The Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division Noncoal Rules and Regulations Chapter 10, Section 4(a) states that "After mining operations have ceased or within thirty (30) days after the abandonment of the mining operation, the operator shall notify the Administrator of such fact and commence reclamation and restoration."
3. During his inspection performed on July 17, 2012, Mr. Don Crecelius documented that the operation has been abandoned for several years. The landowner, Mr. Phil Little, confirmed the site is abandoned.
4. Wyoming Statute §35-11-901(a) provides that any person who violates any provision of the Environmental Quality Act or any rule, standard, permit, license or variance adopted hereunder is liable to a penalty of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) for each day of violation, which penalty may be recovered in a civil action brought by the Attorney General in the name of the People of the State of Wyoming.

NOTHING IN THE NOTICE shall be interpreted to in any way limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this NOV be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.

I have determined that the bond for this Limited Mining Operation should be forfeited. Since this is a voluntary forfeiture, it is requested that the Council approve this request as a final action.

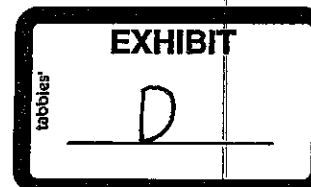

On December 3, 2012, the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division issued Notice of Violation No. 5061-12 to Wolverine Operations, LLC alleging that Wolverine had abandoned its mining operations without completing reclamation in violation



of DEQ Land Quality Division Noncoal Rules and Regulations Chapter 10, Section 5(a). On March 14, 2013, the DEQ requested and received the Wyoming Environmental Quality Council's (EQC) approval to request that the Attorney General's Office initiate bond forfeiture proceedings pursuant to Wyo. Stat. Ann. § 35-11-421(a).

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The DEQ now seeks an order from the EQC to forfeit Wolverine's reclamation performance cash bond (check no. 89085) in the amount of \$4,000.00. If the bond is forfeited, the DEQ will use the proceeds to reclaim the mine site located in Sheridan County, Wyoming.

Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. Ann. § 35-11-421(b), the Wyoming Attorney General's Office is hereby notifying you that the EQC will order the bond forfeited unless you make a written demand for a hearing to the EQC within thirty (30) days after receiving this notice.
