(1) I received a request from Mike Hawks last Thursday on this same item. The rationale from Mike Hawks is getting the fifth round review comments to them sooner will help them to expedite the aquifer exemption package revised submittal. The aquifer exemption package text is really tied to some of the comments on the permit review. So, I explored this option with Chris Lidstone to provide Linc a faster response. Chris did a preliminary review of the responses related to the aquifer exemption. He indicated that he agrees with Linc responses and there are no further comments from him that would affect the revision of the aquifer exemption package by Linc. I communicated this to Mike Hawks on Monday(Feb 25) and asked them to go ahead with the revised submission of the aquifer exemption package. Also, I explained to Mike the constraints below and why we cannot provide a faster response to Linc.

It seems difficult to get a response to Linc before March 15 because:

(a) Chris Lidstone will be out of the office from February 28th through March 4 on vacation.

(b) After Lidstone review, the comments will also need to be reviewed by the LQD staff which the staff would like to have atleast 4 to 5 days.

(c) The current timeline is: Lidstone will get his comments to the LQD staff review on March 6 and the LQD staff review will be from March 7 through March 12 (includes a weekend).

(d) March 13 through March 15 is for compilation and discussion back and forth between Lidstone and LQD. If there are no significant comments from LQD staff on the Lidstone review, then we can get the comments to Linc by March 13 and I will request Chris on this as we get comments from the LQD staff.
