ORDER APPROVING JOINT STIPULATION REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH
ORDER FOR THAYNE LANDFILL AND WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR HEARING


The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality ("DEQ"), Solid & Hazardous Waste Division issued Notice of Violation & Order No. 3230-00 to the Lincoln County Commission on November 20, 2000. The Notice described circumstances at the Thayne #1 Landfill which the DEQ considered to be in violation of applicable solid waste management permit requirements, and the Order prescribed measures to abate the alleged violation. Lincoln County timely petitioned the Council for review of Order No. 3230-00. The DEQ and Lincoln County have now filed a Stipulation for resolving this matter without a hearing. W.S. 16-3-107(n) and Chapter I, Section 11 of the DEQ Rules of Practice & Procedure provide for disposition of contested cases by stipulation of the parties upon approval of the Council.

The Council having considered the parties' Stipulation and being fully advised in the premises;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The parties' JOINT STIPULATION REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER FOR THAYNE LANDFILL AND WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR HEARING in this matter is hereby approved and shall be binding upon them, and, accordingly, the request for hearing in this matter is deemed withdrawn.
