#### **Key Revisions**

- Corrective Action Management Unit Rule
  - o CAMU
    - Disposal unit
    - Onsite management of remediation wastes from HW facilities
  - o Requirements for new CAMUs
    - Design/construction
    - Waste treatment
  - o Regulatory status of existing ('grandfathered) CAMUs
    - 3 at Wyoming HW facilities
  - Will impact Wyoming facilities
    - New CAMUs
    - Expansions of existing CAMUs
- Post-Closure Rule
  - Post-closure
    - Units managed HW disposal
    - Requirements for p-c care and corrective action
  - o Alternative mechanisms to a post-closure permit
    - Orders or remedy agreements
  - Will impact Wyoming facilities
    - Chevron/Texaco Casper refinery
    - Others, as alternative to permit renewal?
- Military Munitions Rule
  - o Ammunition products/components used by DOD for defense/security
  - o When subject to HW requirements
  - o Transportation/storage of waste munitions
  - o Limited impact to Wyoming
- Miscellaneous Provisions (limited impact to Wyoming)
  - o Restrictions on land disposal of hazardous wastes
  - o Exemptions for certain hazardous wastes
  - o Recycling of certain hazardous wastes

- Petition to Council Pursuant to W.S. §35-11-503(a)

    - HW combustor modification
      - no HW combustors in Wyoming
    - Munitions transporter
      - HW manifest exemption
      - reinstatement
        - o automatic vs. specific action
    - Munitions storage
      - conditional exemption
      - reinstatement
        - o automatic vs. specific action
  - Notification
    - Munitions rule
      - munitions outside range
      - records vs. notification
  - Newly regulated surface impoundments
    - Federal statutory provision
    - HW Chapters 10 & 11
  - o 'Automatic' rule changes
    - Munitions rule
      - DOD shipping controls
      - DDESB storage standards
    - Violate state statute
  - o Munitions storage
    - Conditional exemption
    - Repository w/o permitting

#### Comments

- U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service
  - o Comments on existing rules, not proposed rules
  - o Requesting notification on hazardous waste surface impoundments
    - Migratory birds
    - Wildlife resources
  - o Draft permit notification requirements
    - Wyoming Game and Fish
    - US Fish and Wildlife Service
  - o Currently no permitted HW surface impoundments in Wyoming
    - None currently anticipated
