RE: **Issuance of Notice of Violation and Order**

Dear Mr. Fierro:

Enclosed is a Notice of Violation (NOV) with an Order issued to you for violation(s) of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and the Wyoming Solid Waste Rules and Regulations (SWRR). On March 21, 2011, DEQ staff inspected the property owned by RAM Trucking, Inc. located on adjacent properties at 1413 East Fox Farm Road and 217 Avenue(s) C/C-2 in Cheyenne, Wyoming (the facility).

Specifically, the NOV/Order has been issued for the following violation(s):

Count 1: The Act requires persons to obtain a permit before constructing or operating a site that receives solid wastes [SWRR, Chapter 1, Section 1(f); Wyo. Stat. § 35-11-502(a)]. RAM Trucking, Inc. does not have a permit to manage (accumulate and store) solid waste (scrap shingles, associated roofing wastes, construction/demolition wastes, and other miscellaneous wastes) at the facility. Therefore, RAM Trucking, Inc.'s failure to obtain a permit is a violation of the Act and the SWRR.

Count 2: The Act requires a bond or financial assurance to assure adequate funds for removal and off-site disposal of any solid wastes stored at the facility [Wyo. Stat. § 35-11-504(a)]. RAM Trucking, Inc.'s failure to obtain a bond or financial assurance is therefore, a violation of the Act.

The attached NOV and Order contains provisions for the proper removal and disposal of scrap shingles, associated roofing wastes and other solid wastes stored at the facility.

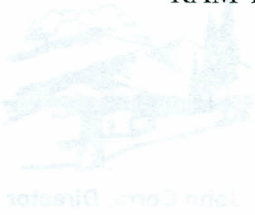

Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your letter of September 27, 2011, regarding the proposed expansion of the RAM Trucking, Inc. (RAM) facility located at 1111 and 12th Street, Casper, Wyoming. The proposed expansion includes the construction of a new 100,000 square foot building and the relocation of existing equipment. The proposed expansion is subject to the Wyoming Air Quality Act (WYQA) and the Wyoming Air Quality Rules (WYAR). The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (WDEQ) is currently reviewing the proposed expansion and has issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) and an Order to the RAM facility. The NOV and Order are attached to this letter for your information. The NOV and Order are based on the findings of an inspection conducted by WDEQ on September 27, 2011. The inspection found that the RAM facility was in violation of WYQA and WYAR. The NOV and Order require the RAM facility to take corrective action to bring the facility into compliance with WYQA and WYAR. The corrective action required includes the installation of a new air filtration system and the relocation of existing equipment. The NOV and Order also require the RAM facility to submit a compliance plan to WDEQ within 30 days of the date of the NOV and Order. The compliance plan should include a schedule for the installation of the new air filtration system and the relocation of existing equipment. The NOV and Order also require the RAM facility to submit a copy of the compliance plan to the AG Office and the SHWPCA District Supervisor. The NOV and Order are effective immediately.
