Dear Mr. Morgan:

On August 31, 1995, the department conducted a SWM Chapter 2 renewal inspection of the facility identified above. A copy of the department's inspection report summary is enclosed. The two issues identified during the inspection have been corrected. A new map has been generated by Inberg-Miller Engineers which accurately indicates the sequencing of the trenches. The Site Development Plans were no longer accurate. In addition, a copy of the permit application has been taken to the landfill, for use by the on-site operator. These issues were originally going to be handled as permit conditions, but have been dropped.

The Sand Draw permit application includes a major amendment to the previous permit with the addition of a 137.33 acre lateral expansion area. The existing facility is 79.978 acres. Due to this expansion, the facility went through a public notice and comment period. No opposition to the lateral expansion was received, and consequently the major amendment was approved.

Based on the department's review of your permit application signed July 7, 1995 and the department's August 31, 1995 renewal inspection, and the submittal of the Sequence and Time Use Plan for Sand Draw SAN #1 Landfill on October 26, 1995, this letter constitutes a Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) Solid Waste Management (SWM) Chapter 2 Permit (#10.195) to operate the Sand Draw SAN #1 Landfill. This permit is valid for four (4) years from the date of this letter and is being issued under the following conditions:

PERMIT CONDITION #1

The Engineered Containment Demonstration Form must be revised within 30 days following the issuance of the permit. The revision will indicate that the facility is in compliance with each of the three conditions.

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PERMIT CONDITION #2

The facility is required to be in compliance with the Financial Assurance requirements for Type I facilities as per the schedule specified in Chapter 7, Section 2(d).

PERMIT CONDITION #3

The operator shall allow the administrator or an authorized representative, upon the presentation of credentials and other documents as may be required by law to enter upon the operator's premises where a regulated facility or activity is located or conducted, or where records must be kept under the conditions of this permit; have access to and copy, at reasonable times, any records that must be kept under the conditions of this permit; inspect at reasonable times any facilities, equipment (including monitoring and control equipment), practices, or operations regulated or required under this permit; and sample or monitor at reasonable times, for the purposes of assuring permit compliance or as otherwise authorized by the appropriate rules and regulations of the department, any substances or parameters at any location.

The conditions imposed by this permit shall take precedence over conflicting designs, specifications or procedures contained in the referenced permit application document. Failure to comply with the conditions imposed by this permit may be grounds for permit revocation under the provisions of SWM Chapter 1, Section 4(b).

If you are unable to accept any of the conditions in this permit, you must appeal this permit by sending a letter stating your objections to the Environmental Quality Council, Barrett Building, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002, within sixty (60) days of your receipt of this permit.

LEGAL NOTICE

In accordance with the provisions of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act and Chapter 1, Section 2(c) of the Solid Waste Management Rules and Regulations, the Fremont County Solid Waste Disposal District has submitted an application to renew and amend its existing permit for the Sand Draw Sanitary Landfill.

This landfill currently accepts municipal solid waste and asbestos from a service area which includes the City of Riverton and a ten-mile radius, and may include the Wind River Indian Reservation. The purpose of the amendment is to expand the current landfill permit boundaries and increase the overall municipal waste disposal capacity of this site. The existing landfill area is approximately 80 acres in size and located in the Section 26, T.34N., R.96W., Fremont County, Wyoming. The proposed expansion area is located adjacent to the existing area and is approximately 137 acres in size. The wastes will be managed by a combination of trench and area fill operations. The total volumetric capacity of the entire waste management area (217 acres) will be approximately 4.1 million cubic yards. Expected life of the landfill will be dependent on the rate of receipt of wastes. However, the application estimates that the expansion area will add approximately 54 years to the existing remaining life expectancy of approximately 10 years.

This notice is to announce that the Department of Environmental Quality, Solid and Hazardous Waste Division has determined the application to be generally complete and technically adequate. The Department has issued a permit review and a draft permit which can be viewed at the Fremont County Clerk's Office in Lander and the Fremont County Library in Riverton.

Any interested person has the right to file written objections to this draft permit, as it pertains to the proposed permit amendment. The public comment period for this permit shall begin on the first date of publication of this notice and shall end thirty (30) days after the last date of publication of this notice. Written objections must be received by 5:00 PM on the last day of the public comment period. Objections must be submitted in writing to the Department of Environmental Quality, Dennis Hemmer, Director, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, WY. 82002. If substantial written objections are filed, a contested case hearing will be held by the Environmental Quality Council.

In accordance with the Americans With Disabilities Act, special assistance or alternative formats will be made available upon request for individuals with disabilities.
