The proposed revision is not acceptable to DEQ because DEQ does not believe it accurately represents the course of events. Following the preliminary review, DEQ did not make an affirmative determination that the proposed expansion does not constitute a new cell, unit, or facility. Rather, DEQ set aside that issue and did not posit any decisions in relation thereto. The proposed revision suggests otherwise.

Accordingly, the language originally proposed, as reflected in the attached document, is the language DEQ is willing to accept.

If we are able to agree on final language, I concur that we should have a conference call with the EQC.
