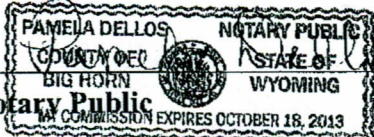

Big Horn #2 landfill.

This facility currently provides for the disposal of municip-
al and construction and demolition wastes which have been generate-
d within northern Big Horn County. The approximately 79 acre facility is
located approximately 2.5 miles northwest of Lovell, Wyoming in a par-
cel of Lot 87, Township 56 North, Range 96 West, Big Horn County, Wyc-
oming. The current total volumetric capacity of this facility is estimate-
d to be 2,143,565 cubic yards. Prior to the requested major amendmen-
t the current life of the facility was estimated to be approximately 5
years.

The purpose of the major amendment is to allow the operato-
r to increase the service area of this facility to include all of Big Horn
Hot Springs, Park, Sheridan, and Washakie Counties in Wyoming and
Carbon County, Montana. In particular, the increase in service are-
a will allow the landfill to accept waste from the City of Powell, Wyoming.
This will cause the original daily tonnage of waste received to increase
by more than five percent (5%). With consideration of the addition
of waste from the City of Powell the remaining life of the facility is
estimated to decrease to approximately 27 years.

The Department of Environmental Quality, Solid and Hazard-
ous Waste Division (DEQ) has reviewed the application and determine-
d that it is generally complete and suitable for publication. The DEQ's
solid waste rules, in Chapter 1, Section 2 (b) (ii), require that the ap-
plicant must provide public notice that a proposed major amendmen-
t has been issued and inform the public that there is an opportunity to
comment on the proposed major amendment before it is issued in fina-

WY 82002. Formal written objections must be accompanied by a
statement of the facts upon which the objection is based. If substantia
written objections are filed, a contested case hearing will be held by
the Environmental Quality Council.

This facility currently provides for the disposal of municipal and construction and demolition wastes which have been generated within northern Big Horn County. The approximately 79 acre facility is located approximately 2.5 miles northwest of Lovell, Wyoming on a part of Lot 87, Township 56 North, Range 96 West, Big Horn County, Wyoming. The current total volumetric capacity of this facility is estimated to be 2,143,565 cubic yards. Prior to the requested major amendment the current life of the facility was estimated to be approximately 56 years.

The purpose of the major amendment is to allow the operator to increase the service area of this facility to include all of Big Horn, Hot Springs, Park, Sheridan, and Washakie Counties in Wyoming and Carbon County, Montana. In particular, the increase in service area will allow the landfill to accept waste from the City of Powell, Wyoming. This will cause the original daily tonnage of waste received to increase by more than five percent (5%). With consideration of the addition of waste from the City of Powell the remaining life of the facility is estimated to decrease to approximately 27 years.

The Department of Environmental Quality, Solid and Hazardous Waste Division (DEQ) has reviewed the application and determined that it is generally complete and suitable for publication. Any comments or formal written objections must be received by 5:00 PM on the last day of the notice period. Comments or formal objections must be submitted in writing to the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, WY 82002. Formal written objections must be accompanied by a statement of the facts upon which the objection is based. If substantial written objections are filed, a contested case hearing will be held by the Environmental Quality Council.
