Kennedy Oil, a Wyoming corporation, by and through its undersigned counsel, herewith moves, pursuant to Chapter 2, Section 7, of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Council, for leave to intervene in this matter.

As noted in the Appendices attached to the Petition for Review which was submitted by Mr. Kirven, the permits subject to appeal were issued to Kennedy Oil. Kennedy Oil is operating oil and gas leases on the Adami Ranch in Sections 25 and 26. If the relief sought by the Petitioners were to be granted, Kennedy Oil would be adversely affected.
