I am the Park County Commissioner who participated in the conference call yesterday. As you are aware many counties are very concerned as to how the Water Quality Standards for Ag Usc will be modified. We heard verbally on the telephone what is currently proposed but we're unsure whether it will change in the final document. Hot Springs County Commissioner, Brad Basse, expressed the need for a socioeconomic impact study to be commissioned which quantifies and identifies the socioeconomic impact of the Ag Use Protection Policy rulemaking.
