WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY'S MOTION FOR SETTING OF HEARING ON MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

COMES NOW, Respondent, the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), by and through the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Wyoming, and pursuant to Chapter II, Section 3 of the DEQ Rules of Practice and Procedure, hereby requests the Environmental Quality Council (EQC) set a hearing on the pending Motion for Summary Judgment in the above-captioned matter. In support of this motion, DEQ advises the EQC as follows:

 On August 14, 2008, DEQ issued a Notice of Violation and Order (NOV) to Petitioner, KDA Construction, Inc. (KDA), for failing to abide by Authorization WYR103444 as required by the Wyoming Pollution Discharge Elimination System Storm Water Permit.

- On September 3, 2008, KDA sent DEQ and the EQC a letter requesting an appeal of the NOV.
- 3. DEQ filed its response to KDA's petition on October 15, 2008.
- 4. On October 23, 2008, DEQ sent by certified mail and facsimile its First Discovery Request to KDA which requested admissions on issues of material fact in the case.
- 5. KDA failed to respond to DEQ's First Discovery Request, and the time for that response expired under Rule 36 of the Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure (Wyo. R. Civ. P.) on November 22, 2008. Therefore, DEQ's requested admissions are deemed admitted pursuant to Rule 36(a) of the Wyo. R. Civ. P.
- DEQ's Motion for Summary Judgment was filed and sent by certified mail to KDA on December 22, 2008.
- 7. Petitioner, KDA, has not responded to DEQ's Motion for Summary Judgment.
- 8. It is appropriate that a hearing be set in this matter since the spring runoff is approaching and an order is needed from the EQC in order to enforce the NOV and prevent additional erosion and damage to the water quality.

WHEREFORE, DEQ respectfully requests that the EQC set a hearing on the Motion

for Summary Judgment in this matter.
