## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS

2. Statement of the terms and substance of the proposed rule or a description of the subjects and issues involved:

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division, pursuant to the authority vested in it by the Act, Wyoming Statutes 35-11-313 proposes to adopt Chapter 24 of the Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations. Chapter 24 contains the permit requirements for the geologic sequestration of carbon dioxide.
